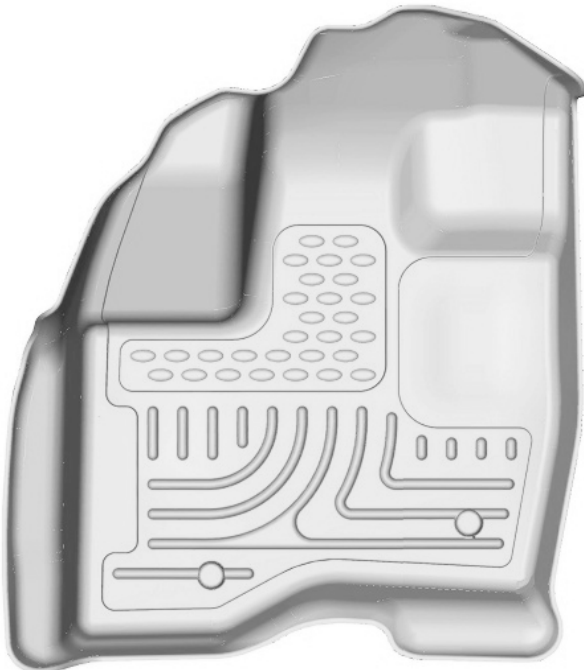

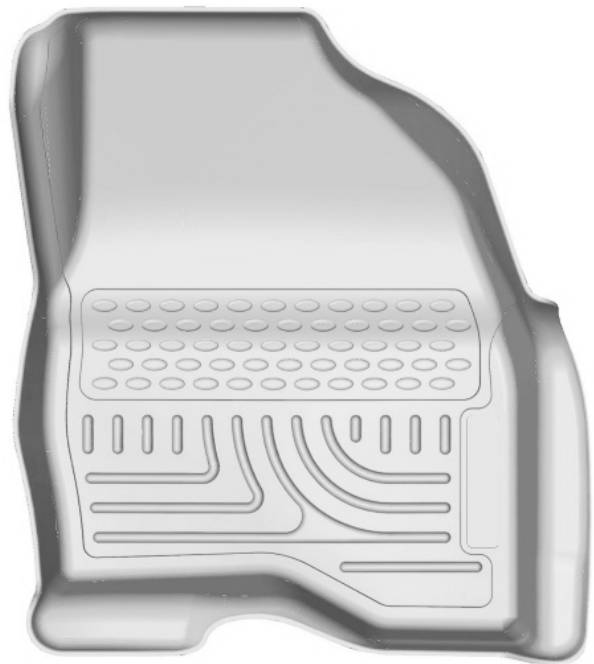

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS FOR YOUR FORD EXPLORER FRONT FLOOR LINERS



LEFT OR DRIVER'S SIDE



RIGHT OR PASSENGER'S SIDE

TO EASE INSTALLATION OF YOUR EXPLORER FRONT LINERS, MOVE BOTH FRONT SEATS TO THEIR MOST REARWARD POSITION. ONCE YOU HAVE INSTALLED YOUR LINERS, REPOSITION THE SEATS AS DESIRED.

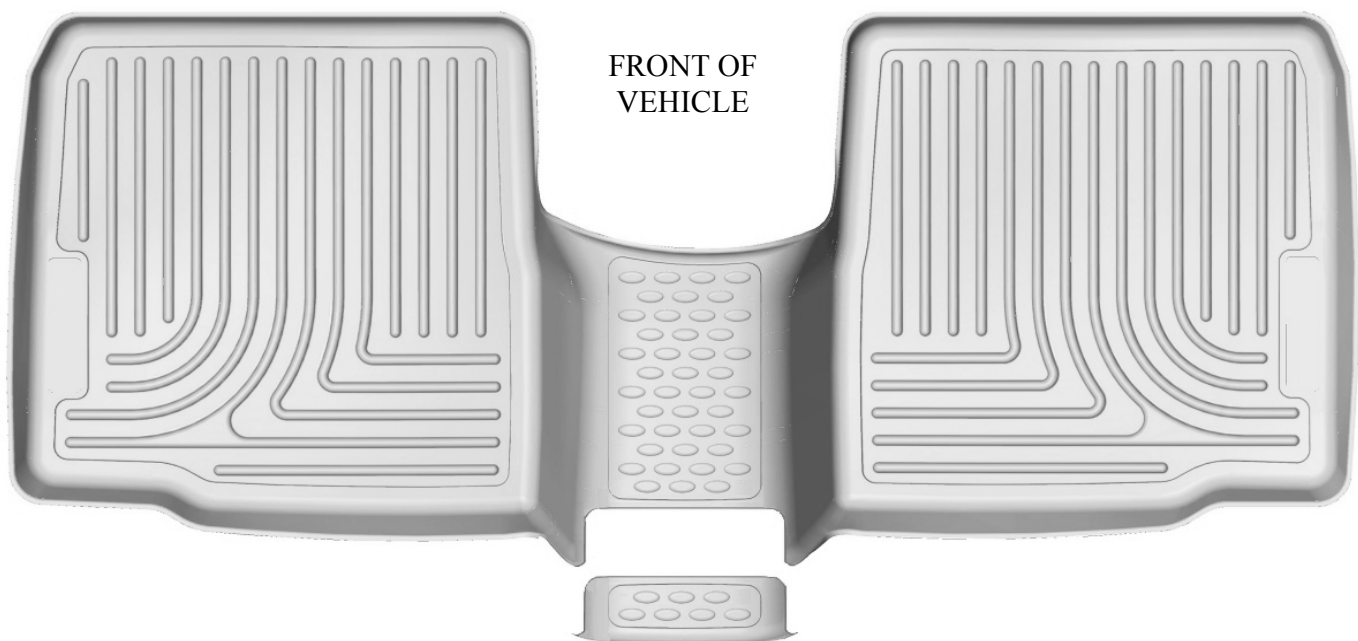

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS FOR YOUR FORD EXPLORER SECOND SEAT FLOOR LINERS



TO EASE INSTALLATION OF YOUR EXPLORER SECOND SEAT LINER, MOVE THE FRONT SEATS TO THEIR MOST FORWARD POSITIONS. WITH THIS DONE, INSERT LINERS IN VEHICLE ANGLING THEM SO THAT THE FRONT EDGE OF THE LINER IS SEATED INTO PLACE FIRST, THEN LOWER THE REAR OF THE LINER. ONCE THE LINER IS INSTALLED, REPOSITION THE FRONT SEATS AS DESIRED.

IF YOUR EXPLORER HAS 2ND ROW BUCKET SEATS WITH A CONSOLE BETWEEN THEM, YOUR LINER WILL NEED TO BE TRIMMED TO FIT CORRECTLY. TO TRIM, REMOVE THE MATERIAL FROM YOUR LINER AS SHOWN ABOVE USING THE MOLDED IN STEP IN THE LINER AS YOUR TRIMMING GUIDE. HEAVY SHEARS OR A UTILITY KNIFE WILL WORK WELL FOR TRIMMING.
