


Tools Required

Rubber Mallet & Hammer, Phillips Screwdriver, Flat Screwdriver, 13mm Spanner, 6mm Allen Key


2.5mm Pin Punch, Drill & 4.5mm Drill Bit (for cast hinge only)



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
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3 Remove Broken Parts




Note:

If you have difficulty removing the broken shaft it can be left within the pole. When inserting the new part in step 5 the broken shaft will get pushed further into the pole.




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
5 Fit New Part to Pole



6 Re-Fit Pole and Bush



7 Re-Fit Hinge Bolt



8 Operate Awning

Operate the awning to check that the hinge performs as it should. If there is too much resistance in the hinge then back of the bolt torque (Step 7) and repeat this step.
