




RHINO-RACK

Rhino-Rack Bike Bar Adaptor (RBCA021)

Important: Please read these instructions carefully prior to installation. Please refer to your fitting instruction to ensure that the bike rack is installed in the correct locations. Check the contents of kit before commencing fitment and report any discrepancies. Place these instructions in the vehicle's glove box after installation is complete.

Layout



Important Information

Maximum carrying capacity:

15kg (33lbs). Load must be evenly distributed over the crossbars. Please refer to your vehicle manufacturers handbook for maximum carrying capacity. Always use the lower of the two figures. Load must be evenly distributed over the crossbars.

Recommendations:

All bolt connections must be checked after driving a short distance when you first install your roof racks. Bolt connections should be checked again at regular intervals (every 1000km or depending on road conditions, usage, loads and distances travelled). You should also check the condition of your roof racks each time they are re-fitted. Always make sure to fasten your load securely. Please also ensure that all loads are evenly distributed and that the centre of gravity is kept as low as possible. Remove any wind resisting loads before travelling. Remove kids bike seats

Roof racks must be removed when putting vehicle through an automatic car wash.

Caution: The handling characteristics of the vehicle changes when you transport a load on the roof. For safety reasons we recommend you exercise extreme care when transporting wind-resistant loads. Special consideration must be taken into account when cornering and braking. **Please remove bike rack when putting vehicle through an automatic car wash.**

It is your responsibility to ensure this fitting instruction is given to the end user or client. Place these instructions in the vehicle's glove box after installation is complete.
